## Set the Example for Believers

This morning we are recognizing and honoring those that are graduating! We not only want to celebrate the work that they have done so far, but we also want to encourage them as they begin to venture out on their own—whether that be to college, a trade school, or the workplace!

I remember the day my childhood church had a similar service. I still have the Bible the church gave me when I graduated high school, and inside of the front cover there is a piece of paper with a word of encouragement written. It contains three Scriptures: Proverbs 30:7-9, 2 Timothy 2:15, and 1 Corinthians 15:58.

Each of those passages provides an exhortation to remain focused, to stay humble, and to keep seeking the Lord in all things. This is more or less what Paul told Timothy in 1 Timothy 4:12:

*"Do not let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity."*

What is fascinating about this statement is that it is a personal direction to Timothy, but it would have also been read by the church at Ephesus. So, not only does *Timothy* know that he should not be looked down on for his youth but *so does the whole church*. They know Paul has commissioned Timothy to set an example, regardless of his age.

I have always found this verse to be both liberating and challenging. On the one hand, it is refreshing to know that Paul expects Christians to avoid being arrogant and condescending toward those that are younger. In fact, *age* is not a valid barometer for spiritual health anyway!

But at the same time, Paul also exhorts Timothy to live a life of godliness regardless of his age. Just as old age is no excuse to look down on those that are young, so also young age is no excuse to "live it up" and ignore the will of the Lord.

So, as we celebrate our graduates, I hope that we will give them the same commission that Paul gave Timothy: *just because you are young, don't let that stop you from serving the Lord and setting the example for the believers!*
