## Not According to Plan

Last week we observed what James wrote in James 4:13-17 regarding proud planning for the future, in which God is either ignored or consulted only after we have set our own course. James teaches us that we ought to remember that some things are beyond our ability to control and plan—and that we need to focus on entrusting the future to God.

James doesn't quote from Ecclesiastes 9:11, but it is a verse that fits well with James' message. Solomon writes from the human perspective throughout Ecclesiastes as he describes the frailty and futility of life without God. From the human vantage point, we strive and labor to accomplish our plans and "win" in life—yet we find our plans frequently thwarted. Solomon puts it like this:

*"Again, I saw that under the sun the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, nor bread to the wise, nor riches to the intelligent, nor favor to those with knowledge, but time and chance happen to them all."*

Solomon is not denying God's sovereignty or providence when he makes this statement; instead, he is articulating the fact that things happen that we do not understand in a world that is beyond our control. Coming to this realization can help us in two ways:

First, we learn *humility* when we embrace our inability to create a perfect "master plan" for our life. We learn to view ourselves as finite creatures that are dependent. Yes, we are dependent upon God for "life, breath, and everything" (Acts 17:25). At a secondary level we find that we must depend upon our genetics, our relationships, our community, the natural world, and so much more. Solomon is saying that our plans are not accomplished just because we are hard workers or are gifted with certain talents—life is not that simple!

Second, we might feel a sense of *fear* as we soberly recognize our dependency upon God and God's world for the future. But hopefully our fear does not lead us to paralysis but *prayer!* Our fearful acknowledgement of our inadequacy can prompt us to *trust* rather than be dismayed.

In Hebrews 2:8-9, we read that everything has been subjected to the rule and reign of Christ Jesus our Lord. But how does that control get exercised? How do we see God's hand in what happens in life? Hebrews says, "At present *we do not yet see everything in subjection to him.*" In other words, we don't have the divine perspective—we can't always make sense of how things work.

But then he says: "But we see him..." In other words, our security and confidence for the future rests not in *our plans* but in *God's ultimate will* for His people!

## Staying in Touch with YOUTH

### A Formula that Works

**F-E+V=2.** Got it? Surely, you’re aware of what that formula represents? After all, it’s one of the 17 equations that change the world! Maybe you haven’t yet learned about what it represents because you’re just in your first year of medical school, but it is, that formula helps us understand the behavior and function of DNA. I’d say that’s pretty important, wouldn’t you?

Let me give you another formula that I think is just as important: **P+P+P= Perseverance, Passion, and Practice**. Anything positive (and on occasion some negatives) that has ever been accomplished has been achieved in accordance with the formula P+P+P. Your joyful life in Christ and the certainty of your citizenship in heaven depends upon your following and applying the three “p’s.” John wrote “*Be faithful even to the point of death and I will give you life as your victor’s crown* (Rev. 2:10); that’s **perseverance!** Jesus declared that we are to “*love the Lord your God with all of our heart, soul, mind and spirit* (Lk.10:27); that’s **passion!** Paul penned the words, “Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me, put into practice” (1 Cor. 4:9); that’s **practice!**

Think about it; if you’re really good at a sport, at playing an instrument, or art, you undoubtedly applied the three “p’s” in order to be proficient at what you do. Yes, natural ability plays a role in your success, but by and large you wouldn’t be the person you are if you failed to consistently persevere through the hard rehearsals, drills and even setbacks, if you didn’t possess a deep desire to be successful, and if you failed to apply all that you learned. In this way in our physical endeavors, we can be sure that the same formula must be unfailingly used if we would be successful spiritually.
