Better Patient Than...

One of the beauties of Scripture is that God inspired His Word to be delivered to us through various forms of literary composition. We have narratives, laws, letters to churches, letters to people, prophetic oracles, poems, prayers, and more! One of the great forms in Scripture for communicating profound truths in little bite-sized pieces is *proverbial* sayings.

These statements convey general truths in a way that is easy to understand and remember. While Proverbs is not the only book to contain *proverbs*, it certainly is the largest and best-known collection of proverbial statements in Scripture.

Sometimes I'll read Proverbs and certain ones make me chuckle! One of them is Proverbs 25:17. In this Proverb we read:

"Seldom set foot in your neighbor's house—too much of you, and they will hate you."

Now, to me, that is funny! I laugh not because I disagree with Solomon, but rather because of how blunt he is in conveying the fact that we can easily fail to be considerate to other people and can "wear out our welcome."

But sometimes I come across Proverbs that are more challenging than they are humorous. These Proverbs hit home and cause me to reflect on my values and where I derive meaning in life. One of them is especially relevant in light of our preaching text for this morning (James 5:7-12). It is Proverbs 16:32,

"Better a patient person than a warrior, one with self-control than one who takes a city."

Listen, when we are in situations that call for patience, it is much easier to rise up like a warrior to fight. When we need self-control, it is very tempting to try to be the person who "takes the city." Truthfully, our world has very little time or interest in patient people! Patient people often get looked past in favor of people who "get things done," regardless of how many bridges are burned along the way.

Yet Solomon teaches us like his children and warns us to prioritize patience above fighting, and self-control over self-assertion. This is especially difficult when we are hurting in some way, but James will help us see that patience is both possible and powerful—even in the midst of suffering!

While we might think that we would use that money wisely and unselfishly, statistics show that 70% of lottery winners spend every penny they won within five years. I’m sure a lot of that 70% made the same vow about the wise and beneficial use of their jackpots as well.
