## Power in Prayer

In our Scripture for this morning's message, we find James reminding us of the effectiveness and power of the prayer of the righteous (James 5:16). As I was thinking on this passage, I tried to think of some of the "powerful" prayers in Scripture and I thought I'd share a couple of them with you in this article.

First, I thought of Elijah. I can't take credit for that; James mentions him in the very next verse! But Elijah prayed to God that it wouldn't rain, and it didn't rain...for *three years!* Talk about a drought!

Why did Elijah pray this way? His mission was to awaken the people of Israel to their sin and their need to return to the Lord! He declared to the wicked king Ahab that rain would be withheld, and so it was. But what makes the story even more special is that God took special care of Elijah—something Elijah did not even request of the Lord (1 Kings 17:2-4).

Another great prayer comes from Hannah, who prayed to the Lord for a child whom she would dedicate into the Lord's service. What strikes me about Hannah is that 1 Samuel 1:12 tells us that she "kept on praying to the Lord"—she was persistent and personal in her supplication.

What is so commendable about Hannah is that she was faithful to her word regarding the birth of Samuel. She dedicated him to the Lord's service, and he spent much of his childhood with Eli, the priest, and his life was spent as a prophet of God's people. How often do our prayers "overpromise" what we will do in God's service as we try to get God to do things our way...but not so with Hannah!

There are other prayers we could consider, but I will share just one more: Jesus' prayer in John 12:28, "Father, glorify your name!"

This simple prayer was on Jesus' heart as "his hour had come" and he was prepared to go to Calvary to die for our sins. He simply prayed that God would be glorified—that he would be made known to the world. And we know that Jesus' death on the cross magnified God's glory in a way beyond comprehension!

A prophet prayed for a drought, a woman prayed for a child, and the Savior prayed for God's glory. Three great prayers filled with all sorts of lessons. But perhaps the greatest lesson we could learn from these three people is not so much "how great" they prayed but rather *that they prayed*. Before a prayer becomes "powerful" and "effective," it starts by *being a prayer*. Let's take our cares, plans, dreams, and fears to the throne of God each day!
