Hearing Loss

I happened to see a projection the other day that the "hearing aid industry" is anticipated to close 2021 as being a 11-billion-dollar market. It is immediately apparent that *hearing* is something that is very important to us as humans, and something we will pay quite a lot to keep!

Some of the technology is truly remarkable. They have some hearing aids that sync up directly to your phone. If you are in a crowded or noisy room, you can simply put your phone in front of the person you are talking with—all of the sudden their voice is easy to understand, and the rest of the noise is greatly reduced.

On a spiritual level, hearing is an extremely important skill. Solomon wrote this warning in Proverbs 19:27,

"Cease to hear instruction, my son, and you will stray from the words of knowledge."

We understand that physical hearing is important to learning, and I'm so thankful for those that labor diligently to help those with hearing impairments bridge the gap. According to Solomon, losing our hearing of spiritual and godly *instruction* is even more serious than the loss of physical hearing. Solomon opens the Proverbs by pleading: "*Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching.*"

Spiritual hearing is so important because without it we will *stray*. He paints the picture of a sheep that *strays* from the fold and wanders off on its own, putting itself in great harm. Without God speaking truth into our life, we are liable to get lost very quickly. We need *the words of knowledge* that God, out of his abundance of wisdom, can provide (Isa 55:8-9).

Our need for the words of God reminds me of Jesus discussion with the disciples in John 6. In this passage, many of the followers of Jesus deserted him over the fact that he called himself "the bread of heaven" and "the bread of life." Jesus looked at his apostles and asked if they wanted to leave as well, and this is what Peter said in response:

"Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."

His name was Thanos, and while he was a fictional character in a fictional movie, he does have a real-life counterpart in our world. That villain's name is Satan, and his goal is even more despicable than any character in the Marvel universe. For you see, Satan doesn't just want to destroy lives, he wants the death of souls- all souls, mine and yours, and he has the power (power that we give him) to achieve his goal. He does his best through trials and temptations to brush aside all opposition to his workings, and he wants to reorder your life to create as much sorrow, anguish and pain as he possible can.
