

Some Advice

My advice for the day: "Don't ever pick up a hot skillet by the handle with your bare hand! Did I say ouch?!!" Yes, I'm very much aware that when a metal object has just come out of the oven that it's hot and that grabbing it without an oven mitt, is, well, kinda of foolish, but sometimes we humans do foolish things, don't we? So, why did I pick up that searing pan, despite the advice I've always been given and have given to others about hot things causing burns? First, I simply forgot that the pan had just come out of the oven. Second, I just wasn't thinking! Third, I had allowed myself to become preoccupied (with stuffing my face and filling my tummy). None of these excuses though, were good enough to prevent that hot frypan from burning my hand when I thoughtlessly picked it up. Oh, how I wished I had heeded that advice!

Have you ever stopped to think about the reasons we sometimes stray from God's truth and will? I believe we miss the spiritual mark on occasion because: (1) we forget what Jesus did for us on the cross. When we forget how He shed His blood to redeem us from sin, we will do things that we shouldn't; (2) We stop thinking about God's love for us and that leads us to forget about the consequences of making bad spiritual choices; and (3) we get preoccupied with the things of the world. As a result, our souls get "burned" by our sin. If we would follow Lord's advice about staying away from even the very appearance of evil (1 Thess. 5:22), we'll avoid all the pain that goes with "touching" the "hot stove" of wrong.
