## Daniel: Contests and Conflicts

Last week, I briefly mentioned the broad structure of Daniel. It's a book that is divided in half. The first half deals with stories from Daniel's life, the second half deals with particular visions that Daniel had in his life. Here, I would like to provide a bit more concerning the structure of the first half of the book (more on the second half later).

One of the things you notice when reading the first six chapters of Daniel is that they largely concern the Babylonian "court" of wise men. This court consisted largely of "magicians, enchanters, sorcerers, and Chaldeans [aka 'astrologers']" (Daniel 2:2). As in many ancient societies, there was a large significance placed upon dreams so part of the job of this court was to help the king and other royalty understand their dreams. Daniel and his friends were a part of this court (Daniel 2:17).

Daniel 1-6, then, contains six stories that illustrate how superior the wisdom of the God of these four Jews is compared to the wisdom of the Babylonian magicians. Tremper Longman, along with other biblical scholars, point out that there are basically two types of stories in Daniel 1-6.

First, there are "court contests." Daniel 1, 2, 4, and 5 fall into this category. In each chapter there is a situation in which Daniel and/or his friends are in competition with the rest of the Babylonian court. For example, in chapter 1 they prove to be healthier and wiser even though they had a significantly different diet from the rest of the court. In chapter 2, Daniel is able (by God's guidance) to recount and interpret a dream Nebuchadnezzar had and the other wise men were not able. In other words, Daniel and his friends are always able to demonstrate that God provides them with greater wisdom than the wisdom of Babylon.

Second, there are "court conflicts." In Daniel 3 and 6 we find that the rest of the Babylonian court has actually sought to attack these four faithful men. Rather than trying to prove they were superior in ability, these Babylonians wanted to simply eliminate the threat by having them put to death. In chapter 3, the basis for their attack is that Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refuse to bow down before an idol of the king. In chapter 6, it is because Daniel won't stop praying. But in both cases, the point is that the Babylonian response to God's wisdom is to try to kill it; yet, in both cases, God proves more capable than Babylon and he preserves these four men.

In many ways, there is still a series of "court contests" and "court conflicts" going on today. You and I are part of them! By our lives, we have the opportunity to display the wisdom of God in the world. We compete with the world's vision for "the good life" by showing that there is a better way: the way of Christ. We face conflict with the world in the form of persecution and discomfort, but even still we know that God will vindicate his people in the end. The message of Daniel, then, can be quite instructive for our daily living as we join the resistance against the way of Babylon!

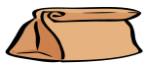

## Staying in Touch with YOUth

### Understanding the Language

Are you ready for a **belly bomber**? How about some **axle grease** spread on some **bleached baloney** or **blind gaskets**? Better yet, how would like to sink your **dominoes** into a **cackleberry**? Be warned though, if you eat too much of this, you could end up with an unhappy **breadbasket** and have to spend some time in the **bandage factory!** Believe it or not, this isn't gibberish, but simply American slang. A **belly bomber** is a greasy hamburger, **axile grease** is butter, **bleached baloney** is boneless turkey, **blind gaskets** are pancakes, **dominoes** are teeth, **cackleberries** are eggs, the **breadbasket** is the stomach, and the **bandage factory** is the hospital. You have to know the language before such things can make sense.

This is also true regarding the word of God. The Spirit, contrary to what some believe, has always been very specific in the instructions to man concerning all that pertains to life and godliness (2 Pet. 1:3), hope, peace, salvation and eternity (Jn. 17:17; 12:47,48; 2 Tim. 3:1,17). But the "language" of God can be like a foreign dialect to some because they read and either choose not to obey it or they feel free to place their own interpretation on it (cf. 2 Pet. 1:19-21)! But if a precious soul is really wanting to learn God's will, that goal can be achieved and guess what? All who approach its study with an honest heart can come to the same conclusion regarding its truth (cf. 1 Cor. 1:10; Jn. 8:32). If people would just allow the Bible to interpret itself and fully believe it is the only authority regarding one's salvation, then God's word will be clear. The same truth that saved souls 2,000 years ago is the same truth that saves men today.
