'Takeaways' from Zimbabwe

"How was your trip to Africa?", many have asked. My replies have been "overwhelming", "a perspective changer", and "Indescribable!"

"Takeaway". Noun. "Conclusion, impression, or action point resulting from a meeting, discussion, or the like."

862 photos and videos are inadequate to communicate the experience! Incredible natural beauty and animal life. Centuries of history, some good, some not. Poverty. Prosperity. Hope. Hopelessness.

But far exceeding all of that, my **takeaways are of God's people there!**

I saw dedication and tireless efforts to spread His Kingdom with far less material conveniences, possessions, and comforts than ourselves!

I returned both humbled by my feeble efforts and far more heartened than any small encouragement I may have been to them.

Thank you for the honor today of allowing me to share **three "takeaways"** from my short visit!

- How can I say 'No' to Jesus?
- "Make choices that benefit us and others, for eternity."
- "The best way to love our neighbor is to help them choose to obey the Gospel." Mark 12:29-31

The Christians I encountered live those 'takeaways' daily! Here is some of what I witnessed...

- Examples of Godly and sacrificial living.
- Boldness to speak of Christ to anyone, anywhere, regardless the cost or risk.
- Commitment to daily discipleship, study, and prayer.
- Fervent worship.
- Faithful, resourceful, and hardworking Gospel preachers.
- A congregation and Christian School, K-7th choosing to stay in a crime and gang ridden neighborhood to make a difference.
- A Christian High School supplying tools for earthly and spiritual success.
- A rural Health Clinic providing much needed preventative and emergency care where there is none for miles around.
