## An Empty Mansion

In a recent interview with The Pivot Podcast, Shaquille O'Neal was asked some questions about his personal life and had an opportunity to reflect on some of his mistakes. In particular, Shaq spoke about his marital struggles and subsequent divorce.

When Shaq started to take ownership for the issues in his marriage, someone started to interrupt by saying: "You can't control that, it takes two people for a divorce bro."

But Shaq quickly rejected that attempt to console him. He stated clearly and simply that he was the reason he is divorced today. While he didn't want to detail all of his mistakes, he summed it up in one sentence: "I got greedy." He had a loving wife who had given birth to five children, but Shaq simply confessed that he didn't love his family like he should have.

At one point in the interview, Shaq reminisced on his favorite memories. For him, winning world championships in the NBA or putting up 61 points in a single game simply wasn't what put a smile on his face. Instead, it was when he would pretend to be a dog and play with his five kids when he walked through the front door of his house.

When Shaq's wife divorced him, he said he was *lost*. He came home to a 76,000 square foot mansion that was empty. That could have been it for Shaq—he could have simply lived his remaining days out in sorrow and bitterness. But it hasn't been...why?

Shaq finished this part of his interview by reiterating: "I don't make excuses." Instead, he works every single day to help make his children's lives brighter in one way or another. He doesn't just "write a check," he makes himself available. "I may not be a husband anymore, but I'll always be a father."

Consider these spiritual applications from this powerful interview moment:

1. Divorce is painful and its consequences are extensive. Married couples: *diligently pursue one another and strengthen your marriages.*
2. Taking ownership and not making excuses is a key for escaping bitterness and anger. This is true after a divorce, undoubtedly, but it is also true within marriages: the more blame we seek to cast, the more bitterness we allow to root into our hearts and into our homes.
3. Your past mistakes—even if it led to a divorce—don't have to define your future. While Shaq understands this on a small scale, focusing on being a great father, Christians have a much greater perspective. Not only do we see opportunities to move beyond our past in the present like Shaq is trying to do, we also see *complete healing* as part of our eternal future: the wounds in our heart can be completely mended and in Christ we can have *everlasting peace.*

## Staying in Touch with YOUTH

### Which Way Does Your Wind Blow?

I once read that somewhere in the state of Ohio there exists a very uniquely built courthouse. Its roof is pitched in such a way that rain falling on the north side of the building will fall into Lake Ontario while those drops falling on the south side will roll into the Mississippi River. What determines the path of the raindrops? Just a mild wisp of wind can determine whether or not the drops become part of a enormous lake or part of a large river flowing into the Gulf of Mexico! Talk the influence of a small, but apparently large influencer of wind!

Influence, especially, the influence of a person like yourself, can make a huge difference in the life of another person. You may not believe that what you say or do has such power, but consider what Jesus said about the way we can affect the lives and thinking of others. He declared that His followers could be compared to **salt**, **light**, and by inference, **leaven** (or yeast). A grain or two of salt can make a big difference as to the taste of food, a flicker of a small candle can take away the fear of the dark, and a small piece of leaven can make dough rise to a whole loaf of delicious bread. So it is with your influence. You may think that what you say or how you act couldn’t possibly help anyone decide to follow Christ or live a Christian life, that you could encourage to not give up, or that you could be the motivation for something to use their talents to accomplish a great good; but that would be a mistake in thinking. Just a gentle puff of your influential “wind” could make the difference as to whether or another gets lost in the big lake of the world or becomes part of the river flowing to Heaven!
