## Lemonade Stands

The lemonade stand is almost synonymous with the "American Dream," isn't it? It requires planning, a strategic location, hard work, and customer service. You can see stories all over the internet of kids that became young "entrepreneurs" by opening a lemonade stand, experiencing how business works, and then starting their own businesses later on in life.

This week, though, we saw lemonade stands not as a profitable business venture in pursuit of the American Dream but rather as a means of pursuing the kingdom of God. Many of our young people (and parents, too!) ran a lemonade stand at the church building, as well as at least one of them running a stand at their home. Why? Because they wanted to help provide Bibles to Zimbabweans in their own language!

They raised several hundred dollars when it was all said and done, and due to your generosity throughout the year the church will also be able to "match" those funds. What's special about all of this is that the kids could have run lemonade stands in their neighborhoods in order to fund their summer vacation "dreams": buying themselves snacks, books, games, sports equipment, etc. Instead, they chose to dream about what God could do with the funds and labored to make it happen.

Jesus teaches us a powerful principle in Luke 12:15 when he said: "Life does not consist in the abundance of possessions." It is so easy to associate "the good life" with a life of luxury and prosperity. One of the great things about global missions is that it helps us to realize that "the good life" can't be about wealth—otherwise the vast majority of the world would be unable to enjoy life.

No, Jesus insists that life is not what you have but about who has you! Being a child of God and a sibling among the believers provides far more meaning than any amount of earthly possessions. It's a wonderful thing when we see that principle lived out by the youngest members of our church family: not only is it an incredible encouragement about their faith, but it is also a serious challenge to us as we seek to embrace that principle in our "grown up" lives.

### Staying in Touch

#### My Birthday

For a couple of months near the beginning of 2022, I spent a long of time in doctor offices and clinics having to provide a lot of information about myself. Invariably, every time with every caregiver, I had to state my birthday! The nurses and physicians weren't being nosy or trying to make fun of me as being an old man; they just wanted to make sure I was the right patient for the impending treatment or surgery.

As I thought back to those "birthday" inquisitions, I was reminded of a far more important birthday other than the one on which I was physically hatched, i.e., the day I was born again and added to the Kingdom of God (cf. Jn. 3:3-8; 1 Cor. 12:13)! Why was that day the most significant of my being? *First, it meant that I had been cleansed from my sins and placed into the body of the redeemed* (Rom. 6:4-10; Col. 1:13,14). *Second, I was made a new creation in Christ* (2 Cor. 5:17). *Third, it provided me with the means to always have forgiveness from my sins no matter how many times I walked outside the truth* (1 Jn. 1:5-10). Fourth, *my new birth provided the angels in heaven with an opportunity to rejoice in the fact I was no longer lost* (Lk. 15:7). Finally, it means, if I truly remember how special this birthday is, that I can live everyday with the assurance that when this life is *over, I am going to heaven* (2 Tim. 4:6-8; 2 Pet. 1:5-11)!

The time may indeed come when I will want to stop counting the number of physical years I have lived on this old earth or at the very least say how old I am in a coded way, i.e., this is the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my 30<sup>th</sup> birthday, or I'm celebrating my Gettysburg Address, but may I never forget or be ashamed of that one birthday that provided me with hope and assurance for all eternity!
