"Wait, what? God Wants Every Christian to be a Missionary?"

Actually,... yes. We know the verses.....

"...Go to **all the nations**, make disciples, baptize them, and teach them..." Matthew 28:18-20

"...Go **into all the world** and preach the gospel..." Mark 16:15-16

God is pleased when someone learns another language and/or relocates to another culture or country for the purpose of Jesus' sake and for the gospel. (Read Mark 10:29-30). Some even use their "secular" job as the 'support' in going (how wonderful if more would do so!).

What about the rest of us, who for whatever reason won't go or can't go or don't go "...to all the nations?" Let's take a quick look at **Gaius** in Third John. First, the apostle John commends him for his faithfulness and love for the truth (vs. 2-4), and how he assists those personally unknown to him. Then....

"Beloved, it is a faithful thing you do in all your efforts for these brothers, strangers as they are, who testified to your love before the church. **You will do well to send them** on their journey in a manner worthy of God. For they have gone out for the sake of the name, accepting nothing from the Gentiles. **Therefore, we ought to support people like these, that we may be fellow workers for the truth.**" (3 John 5-8)

Did you catch that? As individual Christians, we may not personally relocate somewhere else for the sake of the Gospel. **But if not, we are called to be "fellow workers," by either sending or supporting those who do go "for the sake of the name."**

May the Rose Hill congregation always be a "missionary-minded" congregation, with the heart of Gaius, a "fellow worker for the truth," "rich in good works..."

**God's desire is that every single member of His Body at Rose Hill either go, send, or support.**

## **Staying in Touch**

### **Running Away from Sin**

There was once a burglar who was unexpectedly “interrupted” by the police during the commission of his crime. Bolting from the scene, the crook ran down the street, turned suddenly into the zoo, nimbly scaled a wall, and dropped down to the ground on the other side. He fully believed he had evaded capture.- until he discovered to his great dismay- that he had jumped into the cage of MAX the GORILLA! Not being happy to share his enclosure with an intruder, Max tore the criminal’s pants, bit him on the rear end and swung him against the wall of his cage. Doing any professional wrestler proud, the great ape held the criminal in a half-nelson until the police arrived to rescue him- the crook, not the gorilla!

Right off the bat, one can see how the truths of Galatians 6:8- *we reap what we sow*- and Numbers 32:23- *your sin will find you out*- are vividly illustrated by this story. We need to understand as well that because God is omniscient and omnipresent (Psa. 139:1-9; 33:13), that should we ever decide to engage in an activity that violates the will of the Lord, the same realities will mark our lives.

But if we are consistently seeking to “avoid the very appearance of evil” (1 Thess. 5:22) and are instead “holding fast to what is good” (1 Thess. 5:21), we won’t ever place ourselves in the position where we feel we have to run away from God and the consequences that follow our trying to avoid accountability for what we’ve done. If we are daily “running to and toward” the Almighty (Prov. 18:10), we can be sure that sin and wrong will never fling us into a wall of heartache or hold us in a half-nelson of hopelessness.
