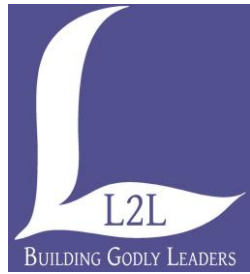

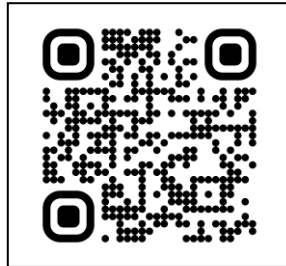
BROWN BAG OF COLUMBUS

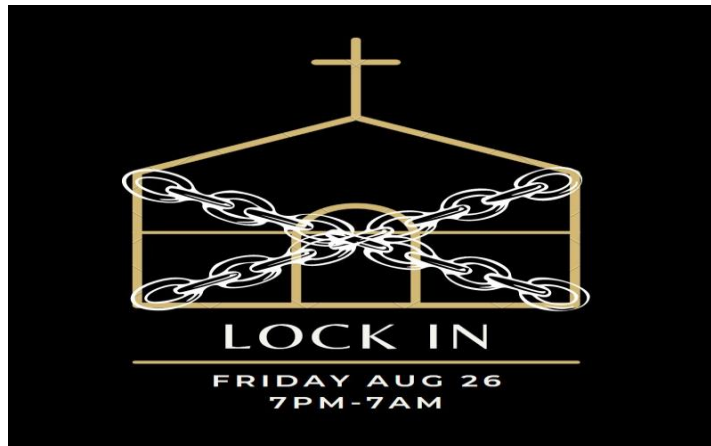
